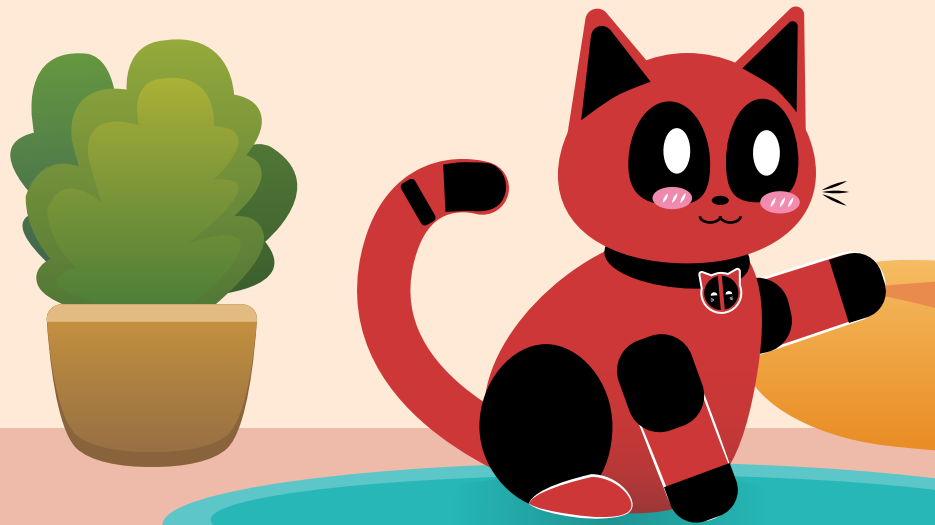


Halloween Safety

respectful choices make the night more fun for everyone!

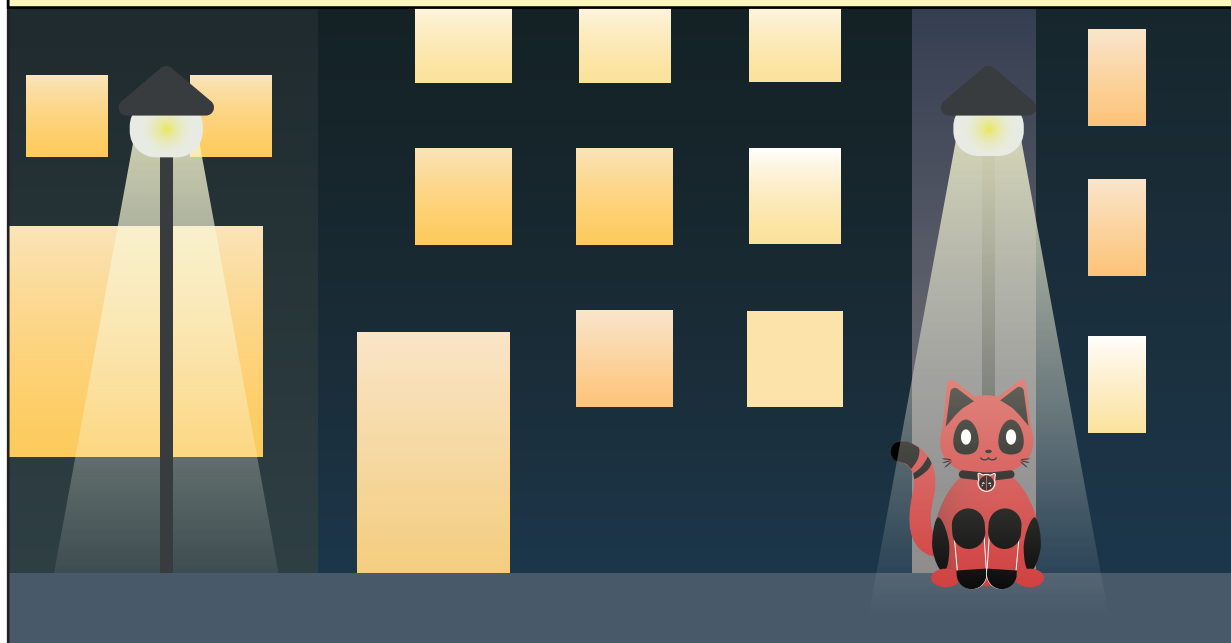
Charge Your Phone: Keep your phone fully charged for emergencies and stay in touch with your friends.

Don't Get Spooked: Stick with your crew and plan to leave together—there's safety in numbers!



Each potion can have a different effect, and mixing them could be unpredictable! Plan ahead for safety and make sure you've got everything you need to avoid any harm




Be Aware: Stay alert to your surroundings, especially in unfamiliar areas. Trust your instincts!
